

### **Sharks Swim Team Volunteer Positions**

In addition to the mandatory parent requirements, there are other areas where we ask parents to volunteer throughout the year. Areas such as social events, team coordination, group liaisons/parent mentors, newsletters and publicity are just a few. Below is a list of volunteer positions we are looking for help with for the 2010-2011 swim season. (Some of these positions are for Dual and Invitational meets but they require training). Please read the list below, and please check any areas you may be interested in.

- **\_\_\_\_\_ Officials:** A Training course is required for both YMCA and USA certification. Training courses are usually offered in Sept, Oct, and Nov. There is a small fee for the course, but officiating can be a very rewarding experience.
- **\_\_\_\_\_ Scorer:** Keep score during Dual Meets, training is provided by experienced parents at the Y.
- **\_\_\_\_\_ Timing System Operator:** Must have some computer knowledge, training is provided by experienced parents at the Y.
- **\_\_\_\_\_ Dual Meet Team Coordinator:** Help to organize volunteers for Dual meets, with help from the Sharks volunteer coordinator. Experience is a plus.
- **\_\_\_\_\_ Group Liaison/New Parent Mentor:** Work with Group Coaches to help organize social events for each specific age group, as well as help to orientate new swim parents to competitive swimming. Must be available during practice sessions at the beginning of the season.
- **\_\_\_\_\_ Newsletter/Publicity:** Work with other parents to help organize and write team newsletter, usually printed bi-monthly. Also help write articles and submit pictures to local newspapers about our team and swimmers. Take pictures of swimmers during meets.
- **\_\_\_\_\_ Social Events:** Help organize and plan on site full team social functions, usually 2-3 per year.
